On March 19th, to help conserve supplies of Personal Protective Equipment, Governor Inslee issued a proclamation that prohibited all medical offices from performing non-urgent health care. I am happy to announce that as of Monday, May 18th, 2020, Governor Inslee has updated his proclamation to allow all medical offices to resume non-urgent health care, provided they adhere to certain guidelines.

This means that starting May 18th, 2020, Pacific Northwest Eye Associates will expand our services to include non-urgent health care, procedures, and surgeries to all our patients at both our Tacoma and Gig Harbor locations.
